Responsibilities include, but are not limited to office and field work associated with the appraisal of residential, commercial and land properties, assisting with taxpayer inquiries, preparation of data and representation for the District in informal and formal protest hearings presented to the Appraisal Review Board and any other duties that may be assigned by the Chief Appraiser or the Deputy Chief Appraiser. Preferred applicants should have a Registered Professional Appraiser (RPA) designation from the TDLR or working towards this designation. High school diploma required; college degree preferred. Successful applicant is subject to 90 day probationary period. Must have dependable daily automobile for field duties, a good driving record and valid Texas driver's license with proof of liability insurance. Successful completion of the RPA designation within 5 years of employment and maintenance of the educational requirements mandated by TDLR is required. Bilingual (Spanish) a plus.
