The Appraisal Review Board meetings usually begin in May and run through July 20, meeting at least twice weekly, but continue throughout the year until all protests are resolved. The meetings may last all day (9-5) or only part of a day depending upon the volume of protests. Will your work and personal schedule allow you to regularly serve at all scheduled and called meetings when properly notified (at least 3 days in advance)?

Appraisal Review Board members are required to attend training provided by the State Comptroller's Office. This training for new members is an all-day training session. Returning ARB members are required to attend continuing training each year, currently a half-day session. Will your work or personal schedule allow you to attend the annual mandatory Appraisal Review Board training provided by the Comptroller's office? (Training expense is paid from the appraisal district's budget.) Sometimes this training is provided at in person meetings out of town and sometimes it is provided online.
